Dear Parents,

It has recently been brought to my attention that some issues have arisen regarding items regularly brought into the daycare. For future reference, please help us to maintain a safe and fun environment to care for your children by adhering to the following policies.

BLANKETS & PILLOWS

When dropping your children off in the morning, please place all blankets, pillows and/or stuffed animals in the child's cubby. Many of these items end up on the floor and become a tripping hazard for children and adults. We also ask that you limit each child to one (1) blanket and one (1) pillow or stuffed animal.

FOOD & DRINK

If your child/children bring any type of food or drink with them in the morning, these must be stored away until snack time at 8:30am. In order to be considerate of other children's feelings, we can no longer allow individuals to eat in their classrooms during unscheduled meal or snack times.

TOYS

Please refrain from bringing toys into the center other than for Show and Tell on Fridays. We try our best to nurture a fair and sharing environment in each class, and outside toys tend to cause conflicts among the children.

Thank you for being considerate of all of the children we care for here at Southside's Weekday Children's Ministry and helping us to keep it a fun, safe, and happy place to learn and grow.
