- 2. What are some of the factors that would have made this woman's disease so debilitating? How long has this woman been in this condition? What has been the extent of her efforts to find healing?
- 3. Pastor Barry mentioned that this woman's faith may have been misguided or defective. In what way?
- 4. Why is taking an active step of faith so important in receiving anything from the Lord? *Hebrews 11:1* Name a couple of the examples of this active faith in the remainder of Hebrews 11.
- 5. Why are the disciples baffled by Jesus' question, "Who touched my clothes?"
- 6. Why is this woman fearful when Jesus stops and confronts her in the crowd?
- Jesus waits for this woman's humble confession. He gives her time to tell her story and reveal what has happened. Why? What is the principle here? Mark 5:19; Matthew 10:32-22
- 8. How do you think this woman's life was changed by this encounter with Jesus?

- 10. This woman overcame significant obstacles to get to Jesus. What often keeps us from reaching out to Jesus? How can we overcome those obstacles today?
- Some commentators suggest that this story along with the stilling of a storm (5:35-41), deliverance of a demon-possessed man (5:1-20), and the raising of Jairus' daughter (5:21-43) are included by Mark to answer the question of Mark 4:41, "Who is this man?" What do these stories add to your understanding of Jesus?
