

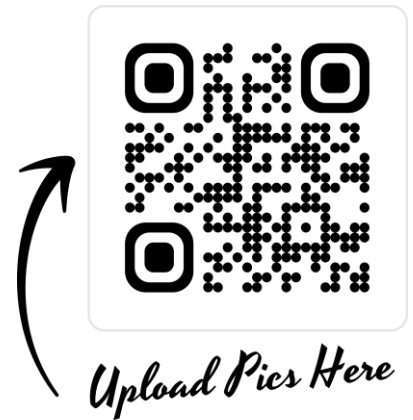
## Pic Crew Sunday Shot List Ideas

**The Goal:** Capture real moments of worship, community, and life change.

### Phase 1: Pre-Service

*Focus on hospitality and the "first impression."*

- **The Welcome:** A greeter at the door smiling or shaking a hand.
- **The Lobby Buzz:** A wide shot of people talking over coffee in the lobby.
- **The Family Walk-in:** Parents checking kids into the children's ministry.



### Phase 2: Worship

*Focus on the congregation's response to God. Authenticity is key here—avoid "posed" shots.*

- **The Deep Breath:** A wide shot from the back of the sanctuary showing the full room in worship.
- **The Individual Response:** A medium shot of someone with hands raised or eyes closed.
- **The Team in Action:** A side-angle shot of the Choir, Band, or Praise Singers.

### Phase 3: Preaching

*Focus on engagement and life change.*

- **The Pastor's Passion:** A clear, focused shot of the Pastor speaking.
- **The Listening Ear:** A shot from the side/front of the congregation looking toward the stage.
- **The Life Change:** If there is a baptism, baby dedication, or a time of altar prayer, these are the **priority** shots of the morning.

### Phase 4: Post Service

*Focus on "belonging" as the service ends.*

- **The "Huddle":** Two or three people praying together or talking deeply after the service ends.
- **The Exit:** People laughing or hugging as they head out the doors.
